

Operation Kindness to Host Free Pet Food Pantry Drive-Thru Event for Community Pets

The animal welfare non-profit will open its Pet Food Pantry to the public on Saturday, April 27

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (Carrollton, Texas) – North Texas animal welfare organization Operation Kindness will open the doors of its <u>Pet Food Pantry</u> to the public on Saturday, April 27, for a drive-thru event. Members of the community in need of pet food and supplies like cat litter, are invited to come to the organization's Carrollton shelter location from 8:00 AM – 12:00 PM on Saturday, while supplies last.

WHAT: The Operation Kindness Pet Food Pantry, typically available by <u>application</u>, will be available to the public on Saturday, April 20 at a special drive-thru event. Six hundred bags of <u>Muenster dog food</u> will be distributed as well hundreds of bags of cat food and cat litter. Free dog food, cat food and cat litter will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Operation Kindness' Pet Food Pantry donated more than 154,000 pounds of pet food and supplies to the community last year.
