

Operation Kindness to offer \$99 adoption fees for dogs over 40 pounds during June.

DETAILS: Often times larger dogs at our shelter and at shelters across American have a harder time getting adopted or wait longer to find a loving home. We are lowering the adoption fee to encourage adopters to consider dogs over 40 pounds more and hopefully get them adopted quicker!
