### **Preparing for your visit**

Our facility will be open each day from 11 AM to 6 PM. Adoption appointments are not required, however, we encourage visitors to fill out an [adoption questionnaire](#) online before visiting the shelter. This allows for faster service.

From there, interested adopters **visit the shelter** and the animal they're interested in. Families can get to know available pets during meet and greets to find the right match. Our skilled adoption counselors can answer any questions that you have.

If your pet becomes sick after adoption, we'll provide medical care at no cost for up to 2 weeks.
