



Summer Camps and Family Volunteer Days Come to Operation Kindness

The North Texas animal welfare organization, Operation Kindness, invites children to explore the animal care world with unique Paw Pioneers Camps and volunteering activities

As spring and summer break quickly approaches with parents trying to find new activities to keep their children entertained, [Operation Kindness](#) is excited to announce special youth programming for spring and summer 2025. Children will learn about animal care and shelter activities through three different events: [Family Days volunteering](#), [Spring Break Camp](#) and [Paw Pioneers Camps](#).

Operation Kindness will host [Family Days](#), which are volunteering opportunities for children aged seven and up, plus their families, to gain hands-on volunteering experience and interact with animals. Family Days for the spring and summer months will be held on the Saturdays of March 8, April 5, May 10 and June 7.

Children ages eight through fourteen are welcomed to celebrate spring break with furry friends during Operation Kindness’ Spring Break Camp on [March 13 -14](#). This two-day camp allows young animal lovers to learn about animal care through interactive presentations, activities and games.

Beginning in June 2025, Operation Kindness will host Paw Pioneers Camps for two different age groups. Children ages seven through ten are invited to Paw Pioneers Junior Camp on [June 18-19](#) and [July 26-27](#). Youth ages 11 through 14 are invited to Paw Pioneers Camp on [June 28-29](#) and [July 16-17](#). During the two-day camp, participants will learn about animal care, behavior and shelter operations through animal interactions, demonstrations, and hands-on activities. Camp days will also be full of fun games and activities, plus t-shirts will be provided for all campers!

All three youth events include a behind-the-scenes shelter tour included, making this a great opportunity for children who are animal enthusiasts to see everything that goes into shelter operations and animal care.
